ITINERARY

June 20 - Vancouver

Arrive into this lively city and make your way to the pier. After security and check-in, you are welcomed aboard the *Queen Elizabeth*. Settle as your ship prepares to sail.

June 21 - Scenic Cruising Inside Passage

With most of Southeast Alaska accessible only by boat or plane, the 1,000 mile-long Inside Passage is a lifeline to the outside world.

June 22 - Ketchikan

Alaska's busiest waterfront, buzzing with float planes, fishing boats and pleasure craft. It is known as Alaska's First City due to geographically being the first place travellers stopped when heading north, and possesses outstanding natural beauty.

June 23 - Tracy Arm Inlet and Juneau

Sail the 26-mile long Tracy Arm fjord, where lush rain forests give way to vertical rock cliffs and waterfalls and icebergs appear at every turn. Juneau is the most unusual and stunning of capitals.

June 24 - Skagway

Gateway to the Klondike, the gold rush town of Skagway, Alaska was once a lawless Wild West outpost. Must-see highlights include White Summit Pass and the Yukon Suspension Bridge.

June 25 - Icy Strait Point

Icy Strait Point is a specially created hub of unparalleled Alaskan action and adventure. Watch for whales or enjoy warm hospitality and hearty food ashore. Bear watching is a big attraction on Chichagof Island.

June 26 - Scenic Cruising Hubbard Glacier

The largest tidewater glacier in North America is also one of the most impressive, a 300 foot wall of ice rising sheer and jagged from the ocean. Unlike most glaciers, Hubbard Glacier has been thickening and advancing toward the Gulf of Alaska since first mapped in 1895.

June 27 - Sitka

Sitka is a hidden beauty located on the east coast of Baranof Island in south east Alaska. The natural wonders of Sitka simply cannot be missed when going to Alaska.

June 28 - At Sea

June 29 – Victoria

Unique blend of historic charm and contemporary charisma, drawing visitors from around the world. Notable landmarks such as Craigdarroch Castle and the elegant Empress Hotel contrast with bohemian shops and restaurants ashore.

June 30 - Vancouver
